
The competition will be played as a 54-hole team event, with the first 2 days being team better-ball matches and the final day being singles matches. Play your own ball all days

#### Your Golf:



Royal Dornoch - In a remote corner of Sutherland, on a latitude shared with Hudson Bay and northern Russia, lies a golf course which many know by reputation only. The links of the famous Royal Dornoch Golf Club stand as one of the great outposts of world golf and one of the finest of all golf courses. Remoteness is part of its charm and the only reason that this magnificent links remains out of the mainstream of major championship golf. Were it in the central belt of Scotland Royal Dornoch would surely have long since hosted an Open Championship. Today it retains something of a cult following, particularly in the United States, fuelled by the praises sung of it by luminaries such as Tom Watson, an honorary member and the

great American golf writer Herb Warren Wind, neither of whom would be regarded bad judges. Donald Ross, a native of Dornoch, took much of the inspiration for his design of Pinehurst No 2, venue for the 2014 US Open, from his home links at Dornoch.



**Castle Stuart Golf Links -** For such a new golf course, Castle Stuart Golf Links has already forged an illustrious history and secured its place in the world's golfing pantheon.

Its spectacular impact began in its very first year, 2009, when Golf Magazine named it top new international course and simultaneously placed it at number 56 in the world list.

Then the beautifully situated course, with commanding views over the Moray Firth to the hills and mountains beyond, shot to wider prominence in 2011 when it hosted the first ever European Tour event in the Scottish Highlands. The Scottish Open, played at Castle Stuart for three successive years, showcased the stunning course and surroundings to a global television audience. Having attracted

international acclaim for its design, location and ability to be playable yet challenging for both amateurs and professionals, the course's reputation has continued to burgeon and it made number 87 in Golf Digest's 2014 Top 100 Courses in the World.



**The Nairn Golf Club** - The Nairn Golf Club is regarded as one of the best traditional links courses in Scotland, hosting a range of prestigious international events and attracting discerning golfers from across the globe. Founded in 1887, the sweeping coastal course was created and shaped from wild land beside the Moray Firth through the combined efforts of legends Archie Simpson, Old Tom Morris, James Braid and Ben Sayers

Ranked ninth in the definitive list of the Top 100 courses in Scotland, it was placed at 23 on the Britain and Ireland list.

As well as those who have enjoyed the course first hand, golf fans around the world have witnessed its competitive beauty from television coverage of the Walker Cup in 1999 and the Curtis Cup in 2012.



Narin Dunbar - When Sir Alexander Dunbar of Boath stepped onto the first tee here in May 1899, he declared open a golfing gem on the coastline of the Moray Firth, adding Nairn Dunbar Golf Club to a 'must play' course in Scotland. Sir Alexander donated both his name and sixty acres of whins and gorse to the course. Our Championship Links Course is situated on the stunning Moray Firth coast. It provides us with unbelievable scenery and a true Links Course. Nairn Dunbar Golf Club is now ranked 9th in the North of Scotland, Top 100 Golf Courses and also added to the 'Great Links Collection', our Championship Links Course stretches out 6,765 yards giving us a PAR 72 over the 18 holes. Our course will test the abilities of

all golfing abilities and promise you a fun and enjoyable round.
